#### Learn more about the job of Humanitarian Programme Manager :

It can be defined as a set of activities planned and undertaken by an Aid organisation, directly or by mean of partnerships with other organisations, in a specific geographical area, over a specific timespan, in pursuit of specific objectives to address identified humanitarian needs. To undertake the activities (often organised in a set of related projects), human, material and financial resources are required, as is the analysis of the program's environment and surrounding actors.

The MSc in Humanitarian Programme Management aims at training managers for the humanitarian and development sector (NGO, non-profit or charitable organisations, foundations, etc.).

## PREREQUISITES

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**Minimum age:** 22 years old

**Required level of education or work experience:**

- You hold a Master 1 level or Bachelor's degree (four years of higher education after "baccalauréat", Matriculation or A levels, corresponding to 240 ECTS) for applicants justifying at least 1 year of professional experience, including experience in the non-profit or in the Aid sector (6 months minimum required).
- By special dispensation, for applicants who do not hold the required degree but can provide evidence of an outstanding work experience (of at least 5 years) with knowledge and skills that are coherent with the MSc training programme. After initial appraisal of their application, they will be invited to submit a dispensation request (VAPP process). If said request is approved by the training commission, your application to the MSc will proceed with the normal selection process.  
The number of students admitted under special dispensation cannot exceed 40% of the whole group. *Note: Applicants in that position are invited to apply early (by ends of May instead of June).*
- Have a professional project in programme management (Programme coordinator, Logistics coordinator...)

**English language level:** Minimum B2 (according to the [Common European Framework of Reference for Languages](#) – Self Assessment Grid).

Applicants with experience in the aid sector, involvement in the non-profit sector, experience abroad, driving licence or first-aid certificate are particularly sought after

Strong computer skills are appreciated.

## APPLICATION

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### 1. Online application

Fill-out the electronic version of the application form by clicking on the « Je m'inscris » button in the gray button below. You will be asked to upload your CV and cover letter.

Your application will be examined by Bioforce staff upon receipt of the 60€ selection fees (we will acknowledge receipt of your payment via email). (Payment is possible by bank transfer, cheque or postal order payable to Bioforce.) Submitted applications will be examined by Bioforce and Grenoble Ecole de Management staff based on completed application package, pre-requisites, expectations for the training, etc. Within 2 months upon receipt of your payment, we will contact you by email to inform you about the next steps.

Your application is accepted until June 30th for the year and from October 1st for the next year

### 2. Interview (if needed)

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Should Bioforce and Grenoble Ecole de Management staff members require further information about your application, an interview can be organized (remote or in-person).

### 3. Registration

Selected candidates will receive an admission email by GEM.

## **JOB AND CAREER PROSPECTS**

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Levels of responsibility vary considerably and depend on your prior experience and skills, as well as the humanitarian context and the employing organisation. Bear in mind that you usually take on more responsibilities over time. Some examples of positions Bioforce graduates now hold in the aid sector, showing various levels of responsibility and leadership:

**First level:** proposal writer/specialist, reporting officer, monitoring officer, project officer, programme officer

**Intermediate level:** head of project, budget, planning and reporting manager, monitoring and evaluation manager

**High level:** project coordinator, programme coordinator, field coordinator, head of office, regional coordinator, head of mission, country director, desk, technical coordinator.

100% of those trained in this course in 2018-2019 at Bioforce are on mission 12 months after completing their training course.
